A Prohibited Person is someone convicted of an offence:

- involving sexual activity or acts of indecency, committed anywhere whose punishment (if committed in New South Wales) could be penal servitude or imprisonment for 12 months or more; this includes convictions for carnal knowledge; or
- involving sexual servitude under section 80D or 80E of the Crimes Act 1900, committed against a child, or
- involving child prostitution, other than if committed by a child prostitute under Sections 91D-91G of the Crimes Act 1900 or a similar offence under a law other than a law of New South Wales; or
- involving child pornography under Section 91H, 578B or 578C (2A) (child pornography) of the Crimes Act 1900 or a similar offence under a law other than a law of New South Wales;
- of attempting, or of conspiring or incitement, to commit any of these offences; or
- child-related personal violence (an offence committed by an adult involving intentionally wounding or causing grievous bodily harm to a child; or of attempting, or of conspiracy or incitement, to commit such an offence).

I have read and understood the information above about prohibited persons. I am aware that it is an offence to make a false statement on this form.

I declare that I am not a prohibited person under the Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998.

I consent to the Commission for Children and Young People checking my relevant criminal records to verify these statements. I understand that this information may be referred to the Commission for Children and Young People and/or to NSW Police for law enforcement purposes and for monitoring and auditing compliance with the procedures and standards for the Working With Children Check in accordance with Section 36(1)(f) of the Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998.

I further declare that I have been informed of and provided with access to the Local Church Child-Safe Policy as used throughout the Greater Sydney Conference of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, and will endeavour to comply with that policy to the best of my ability including adherence to the Code of Conduct for persons who interact with children and young people.
